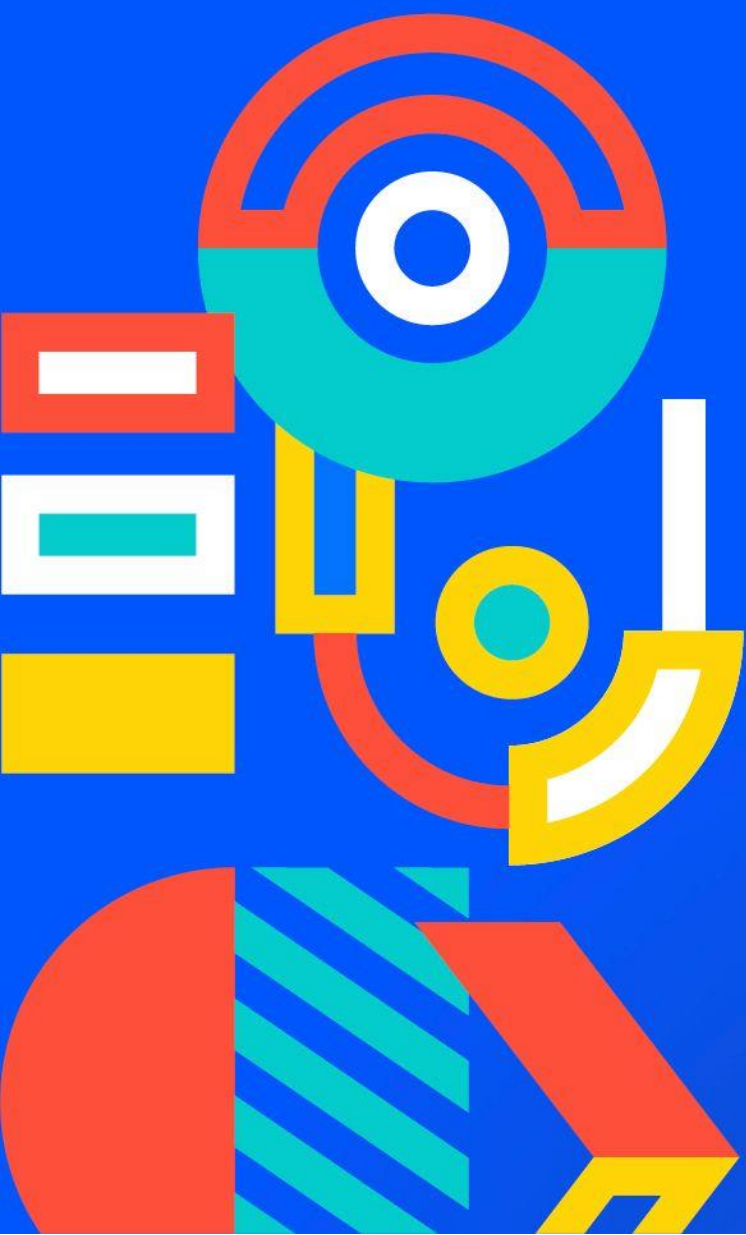

Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form.

Only the NOCs recognized by Panam Sports and whose respective National Athletics Federations are affiliated to WA / APA may enter competitors in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

The NOCs can only enter athletes for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games who have qualified according to the system established by WA and APA.

Athletes who are 18 to 19 years old by December 31, 2023 (that is, who were born in 2004 or 2005), may compete in any event, except for Marathon and 35 km Race Walking.

Athletes who are 16 to 17 years old by December 31, 2023 (that is, who were born in 2006 and 2007), may compete in any event, except for the Throwing and Combined Events, 10,000m, Marathon and 20km and 45 km Race Walking events.

No athlete under 16 years of age by December 31, 2023 (that is, who was born in 2008 or after) may be entered.

Cali 2021 quotas

The following athletes are the gold medalists who qualified directly at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

If the athlete who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games cannot participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, said place will be lost and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete that finished in a different position in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games.

Qualification system

Each NOC may enter a maximum of 2 (two) athletes in each individual event under the following conditions:

- a) Having finished first in the following competitions:
 - South American Games – ODESUR – Asuncion 2022
 - NACAC Senior Athletics Championship – Grand Bahamas 2022
 - Central American and Caribbean Games – Centro Caribe Sports – El Salvador 2023
 - South American Senior Athletics Championship – TBC – 2023

In this case it is not necessary that the athletes obtain the qualification indexes/marks; the decision to enter the athletes or not under these conditions depends solely on their respective NOCs.

- b) According to the maximum quota of competitors per individual event, the first positions will be taken into account in accordance with the ranking of the Pan American area of **January 1st, 2022**, until midnight (Chile time) of **September 18th, 2023**, until the maximum quota for each event is completed. The World Athletics ranking by events must be used as a reference.

For the 4 x 100m and the 4 x 400m relays of both genders, and the 4 x 400m mixed relays, national teams will automatically qualify based on the following:

- a) Having finished in the first two places in the following competitions:
 - South American Games – ODESUR – Asuncion 2022
 - NACAC Senior Athletics Championship – Grand Bahamas 2022
 - Central American and Caribbean Games – Centro Caribe Sports – El Salvador 2023
 - South American Senior Athletics Championship – TBC – 2023

In addition, the Technical Delegates and APA will invite national teams until the quota of 12 relay teams (4 x 100m and 4 x 400m) and 8 mixed teams (4 x 400m) is met, based on ranking of the Pan American area of **January the 1st, 2022** thru **September 18th, 2023**.

Each invited NOC will be able to enter a maximum of 2 (two) competitors to participate only in each relay race. For the mixed 4x400m relay they must enter 1 woman and 1 man. The other 4 (four) members of each relay team with a maximum of 6 (six) athletes (4x100m, 4x400m and mixed 4x400m) should be entered in an individual event.



Universality quotas

The principles of universality, parity and equity will be observed. All NOCs have the right to enter at least one (1) man and one (1) woman in any event.

The NOCs must send their request of universality places no later than September 8th, 2023 to the following emails: jurogo2014@gmail.com, cvwj1@hotmail.com and andrea@panamsports.org

The request must include the names of the athletes, events and records.

Host country quotas:

As host country of the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, **Chile** will automatically qualify one (1) athlete for all Athletics events in which it does not have qualified athletes.

To be validated, the results must comply with the following:

- a) The results must be achieved during competitions organized or authorized by World Athletics, its Regional Associations (NACAC/Athletics South America) or member federations. Therefore, the results achieved in school or university competitions must be certified by the national federation of the country that hosted the competition.
- b) The results must be achieved during an official competition organized in accordance with the current regulations of World Athletics.
- c) The results achieved in mixed events (please refer to Rule 9 [RT9]) will only be accepted under the following circumstances: for all field and track events of 5,000 meters or more held in a stadium, the results will be managed as follows:
 - Results achieved in national competitions will be automatically accepted.
 - Results achieved in competitions that fulfill Rule 1.1 (i) and (j) of World Athletics will only be accepted if approved by the Regional Association.
 - Results will not be accepted if achieved in competitions held in accordance with Rule 1.1 (a) to (h) of World Athletics.
 - Results achieved in race walk events will always be accepted if the course has been certified by a World Athletics/AIMS Certified Measurer.
- d) Wind assisted results will not be accepted.
- e) Hand-timed results in the 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1,500m, 110m/100 m hurdles, 400m hurdles, 4 x 100m relay, 4 x 400m relay and 4 x 400m mixed relays will not be accepted.



- f) Results of all field events held indoors and of 200m and longer will be accepted.
- g) For running events of 200m or longer, results achieved in indoor oversized tracks (over 200m) will not be accepted.
- h) Results of race walk events held in a track (20,000m and 35,000m) will be accepted.

Race Walk

Results achieved at international race walk competitions defined under Rule 1.1 (a), (b), (c), (d), l, (f), (g) or (j) of World Athletics will be valid for the ranking, provided that the following conditions are respected (where applicable):

- a) The course will be measured by a Grade A or B international road race course measurer approved by World Athletics/AIMS.
- b) A minimum of three international or area race walk judges are on duty.

Marathon

Only the results achieved in marathons that fulfill the following criteria will be considered valid regarding the minimum participation marks:

- a) The course will be measured before the race by a Grade A or B international road race course measurer approved by World Athletics/AIMS.
- b) The measurement certificate must have been established no more than five years before the date of the race.

Marathons held in competitions organized in accordance with Rule 1.1 a), b), c), f) and g) of World Athletics will not be included in the list; however, the results will be valid for the Pan American ranking.

Confirmation of quota places

The APA will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places they have qualified no later than September 20th, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to the APA the places they will use no later than September 23rd, 2023.



Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, no later than September 25th, 2023, the APA will reallocate unused quotas to the next best positioned NOC that has not yet qualified.

The NOCs that received reallocated quotas should confirm participation no later than September 27th, 2023.

Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

In Athletics, the marks achieved by the athletes will be valid to be able to qualify for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.
