

According to the quota established by Panam Sports, there will be a maximum total number of Ninety (90) Male and Female competitors in Badminton competition; Forty-Five (45) Female athletes and Forty-Five (45) Male athletes

Each NOC may register a maximum of four (4) men and four (4) women to participate, provided each has qualified in accordance with the BWF and BPAC requirements.


*An exception will be made in case that the Cali 2021 I Junior Pan American Games qualifiers are from countries which have already qualified four (4) males and four (4) females according with the ranking qualification process, in this case the NOC can enter the MS or WS 2021 Cali Games champion.

Each NOC may register a maximum of three (3) players for Singles events and two (2) couples for the Doubles events.

Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form.
All participating athletes must be at least 14 years old.

Each NOC who is an associated member of BWF and BPAC will have the right to participate with a minimum of one (1) player in the Badminton competition of the Santiago 2023 XIX Pan Am Games.



Cali 2021 quotas

Pan Am Sports give to all gold medalist in individual events, in both Men's Singles and the Women's Singles, a direct quota for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, which will not be part of the maximum quota specified within the qualification process for these Games.

Terms and conditions of direct quotas:

Personal Title

1. The quota granted by Pan Am Sports is personal and non-transferable, in view if the fact that it belongs exclusively to the gold medal athlete.
2. The quota granted by Pan Am Sports may not be assigned to another athlete from the same country, nor to the silver medalist of the competition in the event that the winner cannot participate.

Commitment to participate

1. To keep direct classification granted by Pan Am Sports, the benefited athletes must meet the following requirements:
 - A minimum of two (2) participations in international championships with World Ranking Points of the Pan American circuit within the period of August 1st, 2021, to July 31st, 2022.
 - A minimum of two (2) participations in international championships with World Ranking Points of the Pan American circuit within the period of August 1st, 2022, to April 30th, 2023.


Loss of direct quota

1. By rejection of the NOC to the quota granted by Pan Am Sports.
2. Due to the inability to participate by the athlete, due to injury.
3. For not complying with the participation commitment criteria.

Qualification system

Thea BPAC Executive Committee has approved the following procedure for the allocation of spots among BPAC affiliated members, towards the Badminton Competition. Initial allocation is as follows:

- a) Country ranking is determined by adding up the points of the highest ranked player/team from each country in the Men's singles, Women's singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles. (a maximum total from the five rankings) using the May 2nd (week #18), 2023 BWF World Ranking. The higher the number of total points, the higher the country ranking.
- b) The allocation belongs to the country and not to the athlete individually. Each NOC can develop its own procedure to select its competitor(s) to participate in the Badminton competition. To be entered, each competitor must also be eligible to participate in the XIX Pan Am Games SANTIAGO 2023.
- c) Depending on the number of countries that actually enter players in the XIX Pan Am Games, BPAC has the right to adjust the participation levels up (where there are less than forty-four (44) entries per gender in the initial allocation) or down (where there are more than forty-four (44) entries per gender in the initial allocation) to reach the athlete quota, that is, forty-four (44) men and forty-four (44) women.



Confirmation of quota places

BPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and NOCs places obtained before May 10th, 2023 (week #19). NOCs must confirm the places they will use to Panam Sports and BPAC before May 22nd, 2023 (week #21).

Reallocation of unused quota places

In case the quota of forty-four (44) men and forty-four (44) women are not filled in the initial allocation, additional spots will be allocated as follows.

Beginning with the 4th ranked country (three (3) or less entries), each ranked country, in rank order will be allowed to enter one (1) additional man and/or woman until the field is full or all countries have been offered and additional player, whichever comes first. If the field is still not full, then the process will repeat itself until the field is full, with each country limited to four (4) men and four (4) women entries.

For this procedure will apply the following dates:

- a) May 24th (week #21) Panam Sports will inform to BPAC the number of spots to have to be reallocated.
- b) May 25th (week #21) BPAC will inform to Panam Sports and NFs the new allocated spots for the event.
- c) May 26th (week #21) Panam Sports will inform to NOCs the new allocated spots for the event.
- d) May 30th (week #22) NOCs will inform to Panam Sports if they accept the new spots for their country.
- e) June 1st (week #22) Panam Sports will inform to BPAC the new list of spots for each NOC for the event.
- f) June 6th (week #23) BPAC will inform to Panam Sports and NFs the final list of allocated spots.
- g) June 9th (week #23) Panam Sports will publish on its official website the final list.

Competition draw

The draws will be conducted according to the BWF General Competition Regulations as outlined in the BWF Statutes. Draw will be made at BWF offices (**October 3rd, 2023**)

Seeds will be based on BWF WR (**September 26th, 2023**)



Qualification to Paris 2024 Olympic Games

In Badminton, athletes will be able to obtain points for the BWF World Ranking that will be use for the Olympic Qualification.
