

Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form. An athlete is eligible to compete as of the year in which he/she turns 15 years old.

The following athletes were the gold medalists who qualified directly at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games:

If the athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games do not participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, said places will be forfeited and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

The athletes who qualified at the Cali 202 Junior Pan American Games will not be able to earn another slot for their NOC; however, another athlete may compete for another slot through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

Qualification Rules

- 1. The NOCs that finish in places 1 to 6 in the Kayak final event and in places 1 to 7 in the Canoe final event of the Olympic program events of the Qualification Regatta, will qualify for the 2023 Pan American Games.
- 2. An athlete can only qualify one boat for his/her NOC.
- 3. In Kayak, boats and athletes' quotas will be allocated first to K4, then to K2 and then to K1.







- 4. If an athlete is member of a boat that qualifies for K4 and competes as well in K2 and/or K1 in the Qualification Regatta, the K2 and/or K1 results will not be considered for the purpose of the allocation of quotas to boats and athletes.
- 5. If an athlete is member of a boat that qualifies for K2 and competes as well in K1 in the Qualification Regatta, this K1 result will not be considered for the purpose of allocation of quotas to boats and athletes.
- 6. In Canoe, athlete quotas will be assigned first to C2 and then to C1.
- 7. If an athlete is member of a boat that qualifies in C2 and competes as well in C1 in the Qualification Regatta, this C1 result will not be considered for the purpose of allocation of quotas to boats and athletes.

Qualification Consequences

- 1. In an NOC qualifies in MK4 500m, this NOC must compete in MK1 1,000m and MK2 500m.
- 2. If an NOC qualifies in WK4 500m, this NOC must compete in WK1 500m and WK2 500m.
- 3. If an NOC qualifies in MC2 500m, this NOCS must compete in MC1 1,000m.
- 4. If an NOC qualifies in WC2 500m, this NOC must compete in WC1 200m.

If an NOC has more qualified athletes than the maximum quota allowed in Men's Kayak or Women's Kayak, the excess quota of athletes will be allocated to the next highest ranked eligible boat in the K1 Olympic event in the Qualification Regatta.

Host country representation (Chile)

If the host NOC (Chile) does not qualify in the K1 or C1 events in both genders, it will be allocated a quota in said event. If this happens, the number of K1 or C1 qualified athletes in that category in the Qualification Regatta will be reduced by one.

Confirmation of quota places

COPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified no later than August 29th, 2022.

NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and COPAC the places they will use no later than September 2nd, 2022.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If an NOC does not accept all its quotas or does not use all its quotas to complete its entries by number for the 2023 Pan American Games, the reallocation of these quotas will be done at the discretion of the COPAC President on the recommendation of the COPAC Canoe Sprint Committee.







There will be no reallocation of quotas between categories. The reassignment will be made according to the following guidelines:

- 1. If an NOC returns one quota in a category, said quota must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category in the individual Olympic event of the Qualification Regatta;
- 2. If an NOC returns two quotas in a category, the quotas must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category in the Olympic doubles event of the Qualification Regatta;
- 3. If an NOC returns three quotas in a category, the quotas must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category in the individual Olympic event of the Qualification Regatta, and to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified for the doubles event of said category in the Qualification Regatta;
- 4. If an NOC returns four quotas in a Kayak category, the quotas must be reallocated to the next highest ranked NOC that has not yet qualified in that category for the K4 Olympic event of the Qualification Regatta.

This process should be completed before September 16th, 2022.

NOCs that received reallocated quotas should confirm their participation no later than September 23rd, 2022.



Athletes qualified for Canoe Slalom will also be qualified for Kayak Cross.

Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form. An athlete is eligible to compete as of the year in which he/she turns 15 years old.

Only the athletes who have always fulfilled the Olympic Charter will be able to participate in the Pan American Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must fulfill the current Olympic Charter's provisions during the qualification period for the Pan American Games until the end of the Pan American Games' period.

An NOC must participate in the corresponding events of the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championship – Qualification event for the Pan American Games – if the NOC wants to be eligible for an Athletes Quota to compete in the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile.

The quotas of qualified athletes will be assigned to the respective NOC, not the athlete who earned the quota in the qualification event. The total Athletes Quota will be the following:

The above quotas include 4 Host NOC quotas – 1 MK1, 1 WK1, 1 MC1 and 1 WC1 – and 2 Wild Card quotas – 1 MC1 and 1 WC1.

A maximum of 3 (three) boats per NOC and per event may compete in the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championships – Qualification event for the Pan American Games – to earn quotas for the 2023 Pan American Games.

At the end of the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championships – Qualification event for the Pan American Games – all quotas will have been allocated.

An athlete can only earn 1 (one) quota for his/her NOC at any Qualification event for the Pan American Games, regardless the number of boats that said athlete attempts to qualify.

An athlete can only compete in 1 (one) Canoe Slalom event at the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

In case the same athlete is entitled to receive a K1 and a C1 quota, his/her federation is allowed to choose either the K1 or the C1 quota until the end of the second day after the quotas are published in the preliminary result immediately after the last day of competition. If the respective federation does not choose the quota in due time, it will be assigned to the K1 event. The event of the unused quota will then be reranked disregarding the athlete(s) that obtained quota(s) in a different event.

In case that an NOC has not been entitled to qualify a quota for an event in which it participated in the Pan American Games Qualification event, only in this case, an athlete may compete in more than 1 (one) event.

An athlete can compete in a maximum of 2 (two) Canoe Slalom events only if his/her NOC participated with a different athlete than the one who qualified for the first event and did not qualify for the second event in the Pan American Games Qualification event.







The host NOC can compete in the 2023 Pan American Championships in the event for which it wants to qualify to guarantee its quota as host country.

If the host NOC is not able to earn a quota for the respective events, it will still be entitled to receive the maximum quota per NOC to participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games. The quotas allocated to the host NOC will be taken from the NOCs with the lowest placement in the respective events of the Pan American Championships.

Confirmation of quota places

COPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the quotas that they have qualified no later than May 5th, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to COPAC the places they will use no later than May 25th, 2023.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If the 36 Athlete Quotas for Canoe Slalom are not completed, unused quotas will be obtained by WK1, WC1, MK1 and MC1 boats, repeating this order until all unused quotas are completed or there are no more WK1, WC1, MK1 and MC1 boats left to obtain quotas. **Unused C1 quotas may be used for K1, adding them to K1 quotas.** In a first attempt for the same gender.

The COPAC President, in coordination with the COPAC Canoe Slalom Committee, will allocate the remaining quotas to the rest of NOCs according to their performance within a term of no more than 10 (ten) days after the deadline for the NOCs to confirm their quotas.

The allocation of unused quotas will follow the order of final positions in the championships of WK1, WC1, MK1 and MC1 until the established quota is completed.

This process must be completed before June 5th, 2023.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than June 25th, 2023.

Wild cards

There will be one (1) wild card per gender. This quota will be granted to a Canoe Slalom athlete.

To be eligible for a wild card, an NOC must have participated in the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championships – Qualification event for the Pan American Games. Exceptionally, COPAC may grant a wild card to a NOC that did not participate in the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championships.









Athletes qualified for Canoe Slalom are eligible to compete in Kayak Cross only in case their NOC has participated in the Kayak Cross Qualification event with a non-qualified athlete in Canoe.

Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form. An athlete is eligible to compete as of the year in which he/she turns 15 years old.

Only the athletes who have always fulfilled the Olympic Charter will be able to participate in the Pan American Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must fulfill the current Olympic Charter's provisions during the qualification period for the Pan American Games until the end of the Pan American Games' period.

An NOC must participate in the corresponding events of the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championships – Qualification event for the Pan American Games – if the NOC wants to be eligible for an Athletes Quota to compete in the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago, Chile.

The quotas of qualified athletes will be assigned to the respective NOC, not the athlete who earned the quota in the qualification event.

A maximum of 4 (four) boats per NOC and per event may compete in the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championship – Qualification event for the Pan American Games – to earn quotas for the 2023 Pan American Games.

At the end of the 2023 Canoe Slalom Pan American Championships – Qualification event for the Pan American Games – the quotas for Canoe Extreme Slalom will be allocated to the first unqualified countries for Canoe Slalom.

An NOC can obtain a maximum of one (1) boat per event in the Pan American Games Qualification event.

The host NOC must compete in the 2023 Pan American Championship in the event for which it wants to qualify to guarantee its quota as host country.

Confirmation of quota places

COPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the quotas that they have qualified no later than May 5th, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to COPAC the places they will use no later than May 25th, 2023.

Reallocation of unused quota places

In case that the 10 (ten) Canoe Slalom Athlete Quotas are not completed, unused quotas will be obtained by WK1, MK1 boats, repeating until all unused quotas are completed.

In case of unused quotas, the allocation of the first MK1 and WK1 quota will be for the "host country".

The allocation of the other unused quotas will follow the order of final positions in the championships of MK1 and WK1, with the exception of the "host country", until the established quota is completed.

The COPAC President, in coordination with the COPAC Canoe Slalom Committee, will allocate the remaining quotas to the rest of NOCs according to their performance within a term of no more than 10 (ten) days after the deadline for the NOCs to confirm their quotas.

The allocation of unused quotas will follow the order of final positions in the championships of WK1, WC1, MK1 and MC1 until the established quota is completed.
