






## ***Athlete eligibility***

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form and should have a FIG License that is valid until the end of the event.

Men's Artistic Gymnastics athletes must be eighteen (18) years of age or older in 2023. 18 years old athletes who compete as Juniors in 2023 are not eligible.

Women's Artistic Gymnastics athletes must be sixteen (16) years of age or older in 2023.



## Cali 2021 Quota

The following athletes were the gold medalist who qualified directly at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games:

In case that the qualified gymnast is part of one of the participating teams in Santiago 2023 or if the athlete who obtained the place cannot participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, said place will be lost and may not be transferred to a country or to any other athlete who finished in another place in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games.

The athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games will not be able to obtain another individual place for their NOC; however, another athlete may compete for another place through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

## Qualification system

Qualification for the Pan American Games is based on the results of the Senior Pan American Championship that will be held in May 2023 (results of the Qualification Competition).

In the event of a tie in the qualification, the tiebreaker rules set forth in Article 7.1.1 and 7.1.2 of Section 2 of the FIG Technical Regulations shall apply.

The places obtained are for the country, not for the athlete, except for the places granted in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games, which are for the athletes mentioned in the previous section.

In case that the 7 individual places (54 - 60) cannot be completed with gymnasts from countries other than those already qualified (less than 20 countries participating in the 2023 Senior Pan American Championship), the places will be redistributed to the 10, 11, 12 and 13 qualified teams, successively adding an individual gymnast to each of them.

The host NOC must compete in the qualifying event in the respective discipline (WAG and MAG 2023 Senior Pan American Championships) to receive its allocated places.

### **Confirmation of quotas**


The PAGU will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that have qualified no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The NOCs must confirm to Panam Sports and PAGU the places they will use no later than June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.

### **Reallocation of unused quota places**

An order of priority to reallocate the quotas that could be left unused after the NOCs have confirmed their participation has been determined:

1. If a country withdraws its full team (1-9), the team qualification order will be followed to appoint a full new team.



2. In case that a country with a full qualified team withdraws 3 or more gymnasts, it will become part of the group of countries with individual qualification and may only participate with a maximum of 2 gymnasts. The full team quota will be allocated to the next qualified team.
3. If a country with individual qualification withdraws (Teams 10-13) its two gymnasts, the team qualification order will be followed to appoint a new country with individual qualification.
4. Any other unused quota will be allocated as follows:
  - a. Individual gymnasts (maximum one per country) until all the countries that participated in the 2023 Senior Pan American Championship are completed.
  - b. A third gymnast to the countries qualified 10 - 13
  - c. A fourth gymnast to the country qualified 10
  - d. A fifth gymnast to the country qualified 10
  - e. A fourth gymnast to the country qualified 11 and so on.

NOTE: In any other unexpected case, the corresponding TC will make the decision with the approval of the PAGU.

If necessary, the Pan American Gymnastics Union will confirm the reallocation of unused quota places no later than June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The NOCs that receive reallocated places must confirm their participation no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

### **Additional observations**

The maximum number of persons that a NOC may officially register is the following:

Gymnasts	According to qualification
Coaches	A maximum of 3 (countries with full team) / 1 (countries with individual gymnasts) Maximum 1 for the gymnast qualified in Cali 2021 only in case his/her country qualifies a Team and he/she is not part of it, or if he/she is the third individual gymnast of his/her country.
Judges	A maximum of 3 depending on the number of qualified athletes and the FIG Category Additionally, the Members of the PAGU Technical Committees The final number of judges per country may be adjusted depending on the availability and FIG Categories.
Head of delegation	A maximum of 1 (same for WAG and MAG)




All Federations qualified by team have the right to participate with a team of 3-5 gymnasts. A sixth alternate gymnast is not allowed.

The team must be composed of no more than 4 gymnasts competing in each apparatus and the 3 best scores of each apparatus will be considered for the team's total.


## **Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games**

In Artistic Gymnastics, the best positioned athletes in the Individual All Around Final Competition (WAG or MAG respectively) who have not yet qualified for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games with other criteria will obtain direct qualification. (See Criteria 7 of the FIG Qualification System for Olympic Games Paris 2024).



If the athlete who obtained the place cannot participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, said place will be lost and may not be transferred to a country or to any other athlete who finished in another place in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games.

The athlete who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games will not be able to obtain another place for her NOC; however, she may be part of the Team that seeks to obtain 2 quotas for the NOC. If the NOC does not obtain the quotas with the Team, it is possible that another athlete obtains another individual quota through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

## Qualification system

Qualification for the Pan American Games is based on the results of the 2023 Senior Pan American Championship that will be held in May 2023 (results from the Qualification Competition).

In the event of a tie in the qualification, the tiebreaker rules set forth in Article 7.1.2 and 7.2.1 of Section 3 of the FIG Technical Regulations shall apply for the places that are determined by the Individual and Group All-Around's results respectively.


For the places that are determined according to the Teams' results, the following tiebreaker criteria shall apply:

1. Sum of the 12 best scores registered by the Team's gymnasts.
2. Sum of the 11 best scores registered by the Team's gymnasts.

The places obtained are for the country, not for the athlete, except for the place granted in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games, which is for the athlete mentioned in the previous section

### Individual Quotas

For the NOC to receive the assigned quotas, it must compete in the qualification event in the respective competitions (Individual and Groups in the 2023 RG Senior Pan American Championship).

## ***Confirmation of quotas***


The PAGU will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that have qualified no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The NOCs must confirm to Panam Sports and PAGU the places they will use no later than June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.

## ***Reallocation of unused quota places***

### Individual Competition

1. If a country with 2 individual gymnasts (places 1 – 12) declines participation of 1 or 2 gymnasts, the 2 quotas will be granted to the following country according to the team results of the Qualification Competition. The country that declined may keep 1 individual quota (places 13 – 16) if the gymnast was placed among the top 4 in the general individual all-around qualification, discarding the countries that obtained 2 quotas based on their teams' results.
2. In case that the Host NOC qualifies for the individual events based on any of the 2 first criteria, the Host NOC's individual quota will be reallocated to the next NOC according to the general individual all-around qualification, and that has not qualified under any other criteria.
3. If a country with an individual quota (places 13 – 17) withdraws its gymnast, the individual qualification order will be followed to assign the quota to a new country under this parameter.



## Groups Competition

1. If a country with a Group (places 1 – 7) declines its participation, the quota will be granted to the following country according to the all-around positions of the Group Qualification Competition.
2. In case that the Host NOC qualifies its group according to the first criteria, the Host NOC's team quota will be reallocated to the next NOC in the all-around qualification that has not qualified yet under another criteria.

All countries that qualify a Group are entitled to participate with 5 gymnasts. A sixth reserve gymnast is not allowed.

NOTE: In any other unexpected case, the corresponding TC will make the decision with the approval of the PAGU leadership.


If necessary, the Pan American Gymnastics Union will confirm the reallocation of unused quota places no later than June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The NOCs that receive reallocated places must confirm their participation no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

## ***Additional observations***

The maximum number of persons that a NOC may officially register is the following



Judges	A maximum of 2 depending on the number of qualified athletes and the FIG Category Additionally, the Members of the PAGU Technical Committees. The final number of judges per country may be adjusted depending on availability and the FIG Categories.
Head of delegation	A maximum of 1




## Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

In Rhythmic Gymnastics, the best ranked athlete in the Individual All Around Competition and the best ranked Group in the Group All Around Competition that have not yet qualified for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games with other criteria, will obtain direct qualification for said event. (See Criteria 3 of the FIG Qualification System for the Individual and Group Competitions of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games).

For the Host NOC to receive the assigned quota, it must compete in the qualification competition in the respective category and event (2023 Trampoline Pan American Championship, Senior category).

“All NOCs qualified with 2 or more gymnasts must compete in the Synchronized event.

In case that the Host NOC does not qualify an athlete for one of the events, the Host NOC may add one (1) additional quota for a representative from the country on the event for which it has not qualified. This additional quota must be granted with the approval of Panam Sports, the Games Organizing Committee and the National Olympic Committee. This quota must be additional to the 12 allocated among the qualified NOCs and the host country must compete in the qualification competition in the respective category and event (2023 Trampoline Pan American Championship, Senior category).

### ***Confirmation of quotas***

The PAGU will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that have qualified no later than June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The NOCs must confirm to Panam Sports and PAGU the places they will use no later than June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.


### ***Reallocation of unused quota places***

An order of priority to reallocate the quotas that could be left unused after the NOCs have confirmed their participation has been determined. The quotas will be reallocated according to the following criteria:

1. The gymnast from the next best ranked country in the 2023 Pan American Gymnastics Championship.
2. In case that the two (2) individual quotas (11 – 12) cannot be completed with gymnasts from countries other than those already qualified (less than 7 countries participating in the 2023 Trampoline Pan American Championship, Senior category), the quotas will be reallocated appointing a second gymnast from the countries with only one (1) gymnast, following the first qualification criteria.

If necessary, the Pan American Gymnastics Union will confirm the reallocation of unused quota places no later than June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The NOCs that receive reallocated places must confirm their participation no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.



## Additional observations

The maximum number of persons that a NOC may officially register is the following:

Gymnasts	According to qualification.
Coaches	A maximum of 1 per gender. 1 additional coach for the athlete who qualified in Cali 2021, in case that his/her NOC qualifies with 2 additional athletes per gender (3 in total).
Judges	By appointment of the TRA PAGU Technical Committee of the UPAG, a maximum of 1 per country who fulfills the required FIG Category. If possible, priority will be given to the qualified countries and to the PAGU Technical Committee's members. The final number of judges per country may be adjusted depending on availability and the FIG Categories.
Head of delegation	A maximum of 1.

## Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

In Trampoline, the best ranked athletes in the Individual Final who have not qualified yet and if there are still quotas available for the Americas will obtain direct qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. (See Criteria 3 of the FIG Qualification System for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games).
