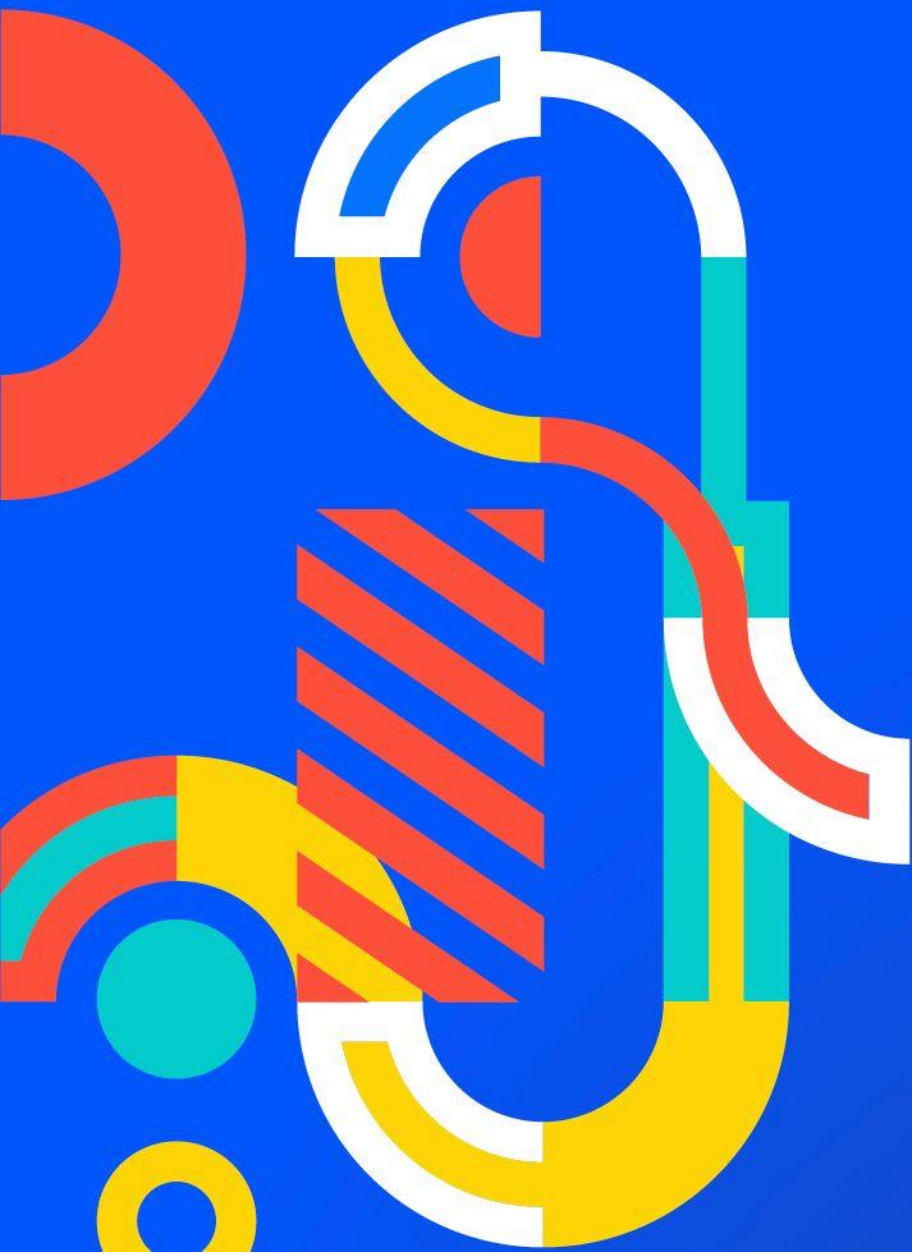

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form.

## Cali 2021 Quotas

The following athletes were the gold medalists who qualified directly at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games:

If the athletes who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games do not participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, said places will be forfeited and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

The athletes who qualified at the Cali 202 Junior Pan American Games will not be able to earn another slot for their NOC; however, another athlete may compete for another slot through the Santiago 2023 qualification system within the maximum quota per NOC.

### Women

A Federation that qualifies in the W4x event at the Qualification Regatta will automatically receive entries for the W1x and W2x and will not be able to independently qualify entries for the W1x and W2x. In the event that a W4x qualification position is not used due to a low number of entries at the Qualification Regatta, for every W4x qualification not used, the available qualification positions for direct qualification for the W2x will be increased by 1 each and the qualification positions for direct qualification of the W1x will be increased by 2 each.



A Federation that qualifies in the W4- event at the Qualification Regatta will automatically qualify entries for the W2- and will not be able to independently qualify entries for the W2-. In case that a W4- qualification position is not used due to a low number of entries at the Qualification Regatta, for every W4- qualification not used the available qualification positions for direct qualification for the W2- will be increased by 2 each.

## Men

A Federation that qualifies in the M4x event at the Qualification Regatta will automatically receive entries for the M1x and M2x and will not be able to independently qualify entries for the M1x and M2x. In case that a M4x qualification position is not used due to a low number of entries at the Qualification Regatta, for every M4x qualification not used the available qualification positions for direct qualification for the M2x will be increased by 1 each and the qualification positions for direct qualification of the M1x will be increased by 2 each.

A Federation that qualifies in the M4- event Qualification Regatta will automatically qualify entries for the M2- and will not be able to independently qualify entries for the M2-. In case that a M4- qualification position is not used due to a low number of entries at the Qualification Regatta, for every M4- qualification not used the available qualification positions for direct qualification for the M2- will be increased by 2 each.

**Coxswains** – the 6 remaining quota positions can be used for coxswains for the Mix 8+. The coxswains can be of either gender.

Each mixed 8+ will be composed of 4 men, 4 women and a coxswain of either gender. There would not be a qualification for the Mixed 8+. Instead, it will be composed of athletes that have qualified in other events and are doubling up into the Mixed 8+.

## Confirmation of quota places

COPARE will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified no later than **April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023**.

NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and COPARE the places they will use no later than **April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.



## Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, COPARE will reallocate unused quota places to the next best ranked NOC that has not qualified yet. This process will finalize by **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023**.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than on **May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023**.
