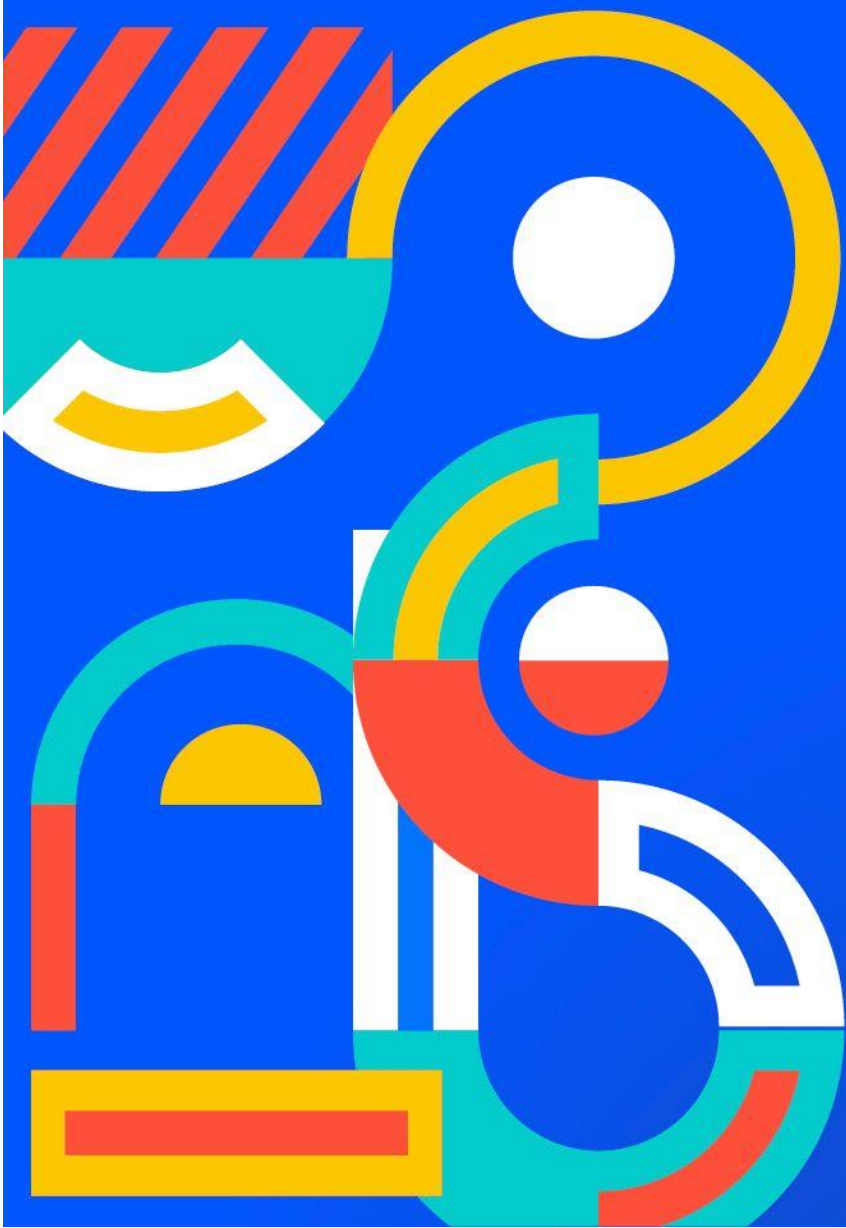

## Athlete eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form. All participating male athletes must be at least 14 years old and women athletes must be 15 years old, and fulfill the qualification requirements for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.

Only the NOCs recognized by Panam Sports whose National Tennis Federation is affiliated to the Pan American Tennis Confederation and the International Tennis Federation (ITF) may enter athletes to compete in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games.

## Cali 2021 Quotas

The following athletes were the gold medal winners in the individual events who qualified directly at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games:

If the athlete who qualified at the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games does not participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, the quota will be lost and cannot be transferred to another NOC or athlete.

## Qualification system

As host country, Chile will qualify automatically for the Tennis competitions of the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games with a full team (three men and three women).

The quotas are for the athletes, not for their NOC.

## Pre-registration process and wild cards

All National Olympic Committees must send the **list of the athletes that they wish to register** and will have from August the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023, to do so. A list based on the ranking criteria explained above will be prepared to determine the athletes selected for the competition.

The NOCs that wish to request **wild cards** must submit their request no later than September 11, 2023.

The athletes who are not selected will be ordered according to their position in the ATP or WTA ranking; if they are not positioned in these rankings, then the ITF World Tennis Tour ranking will be used (if the athletes are not positioned in this ranking either, they will be ordered by draw), so that the athletes may be entered through the reallocation of unused quota places, in accordance with Panam Sports' rules regarding this issue.

For an athlete to be entitled to a reallocated quota, he or she must be included in the pre-registration list.

The pre-registration process is different from the entries by number and the long list that the National Olympic Committees must submit through the Games' system no later than July 20, 2023.

### ***Confirmation of quota places***

Before September 14, 2023, the Pan American Tennis Confederation will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the places that each NOC has qualified.

Before September 20, 2023, the NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to the Pan American Tennis Confederation the places they will use.

### ***Reallocation of unused quota places***

If necessary, the Pan American Tennis Confederation will reallocate unused quota places to the next best positioned athlete who has not qualified yet and who is included in the pre-registration list. This process will be finalized by September 22, 2023.

The NOCs that received reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than September 25, 2023.

### ***Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games***

In Tennis, the gold and silver medalists in the singles events will obtain direct qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games.

Conditions:

1. The athletes must be among the top 400 of the world ranking by the entry deadline for the Olympic Games.
2. The athlete must be within the maximum quota of 4 players per country; that is, that the country that obtains the quota has not completed the 4 by direct acceptance.

If any of the conditions above is not fulfilled, the quota will be awarded to the bronze medalist.
